TOURNAMENT RULES

- There will be a check in table at each location. Check in should be at a minimum 1 hour prior to your first game. Each team must present their ASA roster, proof of insurance, and copies of birth certificates must be available upon request.
- All ASA rules will be followed unless otherwise stated below.
- Pool play schedule will be via a blind drawing. If you have any special time requests we cannot guarantee however we will make every attempt to work with teams to make the best possible schedule for everyone involved.
- Seeding will be based on pool play results. 2 points for a win, 1 point for a tie, and 0 points for a loss. In the case of a tie breaker we will go to:
 1. Head to head results
 2. Runs allowed
 3. Runs scored
 4. Coin toss by the tournament director
- Rainout / Refund Policy: In the event that Saturday is rained out we will have pool play on Sunday with the winner crowned based upon how teams seed. If no games are played each team will be refunded \$267.00 (2/3 of your registration). If your team plays 1 game you will be refunded \$200.00 (1/2 of your registration). If your team plays 2 games or more there will be no refund. All refunds will be mailed within 7 calendar days from the closing of the tournament.
- We reserve the right to modify the tournament in order to reach a successful ending to the tournament. (example, weather)
- The umpires are in charge of the games. Respect their decisions. The tournament director may issue additional penalties when an ejection occurs. Such penalties will be judged on a case by case basis. Any ejections made by any umpire will be enforced for the duration of the tournament. The team managers are responsible for the actions of the coaches, players, and parents of his/her organization.
- With the exception of the semi-finals & finals, no inning will start after the 80 minute mark. Pool games may end in a tie. If time permits pool play can go into a tie breaker using the ITB rule. Semi-final and finals will have no time limit.

- Run Ahead Rule (Mercy Rule) will be in effect. 15 after 3, 12 after 4, and 8 after 5.
- Each field will have 1-2 people there to maintain it. They will be in charge of reporting all scores to the scoring table. All results will be kept up to date and posted at the main table as well as on the CT Challengers team website.

- For pool play the home team will be decided via coin flip. During elimination play the higher seed will have choice.
- Teams are allowed to use one AP (Additional Player). The decision to use or not use additional player is optional but it must be made before the start of the game. A team that uses the additional players bats 10 players for the entire game. Any nine (9) of the (10) may play defensive. Players can change defensive positions at any time. Just as a player can change from shortstop to left fielder, the additional player can play defensive at any position and that player sits out for all or part of the game. As long as a player is in batting order, she is in the game. The AP can be substituted for and re-entered just like any other player.

- Raymond Ouellet Park: 10 Old Canterbury Tpke, Norwich CT 06360.
Where Route 2 meets Washington Street in Norwich (near Backus Hospital), go up Harland road to Canterbury Turnpike which enters from left. (This is at a hard curve to the right) Turn left onto Canterbury Turnpike and go short distance to first left which has a sign for Raymond Ouillette Park.

- Preston Community Park: #13 ROUTE 117, PRESTON, CT
